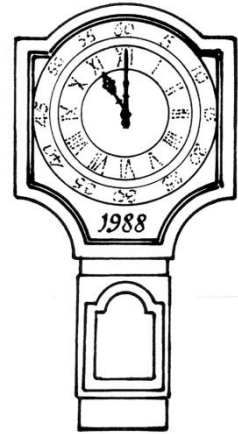

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Gift Aid Declaration

You can make your subscription worth more if you Gift Aid it. The Chapels Society will receive an additional 25p on every pound you give at no extra cost to you. This means that every gift is now worth 25%, turning a subscription of £15 into £18.75.

To qualify for Gift Aid, you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year.

NOTES

- 1) Please notify the Society's Treasurer if you:
 - a) want to cancel this declaration
 - b) change your name or home address
 - c) no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains. Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax, currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25p for every £1 donated.
- 2) If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
